Crime/Incident Breakdown

MULGRAVE GGN

01/08/2022- Criminal Damage – Runswick Bay

Reports of offensive graffiti on a bench on the Cleveland Way. Officers were unable to locate the bench at the time, enquiries ongoing

02/08/2022- Criminal Damage- Sandsend

Victim reports their vehicle being struck by golf balls whilst parked. Victim is in contact with golf club manager, reported for insurance purposes.

02/08/2022- Theft- Hutton Mulgrave

Reports of some valuable items being taken from an address, believed to have been done by an ex-partner. Enquiries ongoing.

03/08/2022- Road Related Offence- Sandsend

One arrested for drug driving. Under investigation.

04/08/2022- Violence- Selly Hill

Victim reports that while they were delivering a parcel they have been bitten by a dog resulting in two puncture wounds and bruising. Victim did not want police action but wanted the owner of the dog spoken to and advised about keeping their dogs inside when deliveries are being made.

10/08/22- Drugs- Sandsend

One vehicle stopped due to drug markers. Vehicle and occupants searched; negative gain.

12/08/22- Suspicious Circumstances- Hinderwell

Reports of door to door sellers going round Hinderwell. Officers spoke to suspects, gave words of advice and asked to leave the area.

13/08/22- Road Related Offence- Scaling Dam

Reports of driver driving over limit after leaving an event and driving towards Cleveland area. Vehicle later involved in a single vehicle RTC at Scaling Dam and driver was arrested and charged.

14/08/22- Road Related Offence – Staithes

One arrested for disqualified driving and driving with no insurance. After a search of the vehicle passenger and driver further arrested for supply of class A. Under investigation.

19/08/22- Road Related Offence- Scaling Dam

One vehicle stopped and searched due to marker for poaching in the area. No evidence of anything in vehicle for poaching , words of advice given.

20/08/22- Suspicious Circumstances- Staithes

Reports of males trying car door handles. Area searched, negative gain.

25/08/22- Burglary- Runswick Bay

Reports that the lifeguard station had been broken into and a charity box containing around £200 taken. Under investigation.

26/08/22- Road Related Offence- Hinderwell

Victim reports a car failing to give way on a narrow road and driving towards them at speed. Driver of this vehicle then got out and starting video recording. Suspect driver visited at home address and given words of advice.

27/08/22 – Criminal Damage – Sandsend

Reports of damage to a window believed to be due to a dispute. No CCTV or witnesses, no lines of enquiry.

30/08/22- Drugs- Lythe

One vehicle stopped in Lythe due to markers for drugs. Two occupants arrested and vehicle searched ; various items of interest found.

30/08/22- Fraud- East Barnby

Victim reports fraud through Facebook stating they have bought a phone through Facebook and being given a fraudulent address to collect it from after partly paying for it. Action Fraud investigating.

31/08/22- Road Related Offence- Scaling Dam

One driver given a Section 59 warning and reported for careless and inconsiderate driving.

There have been two domestic incidents this month.

There have been five road traffic collisions this month, two damage only and three minor injury.

DANBY GGC

03/08/22- Fraud- Danby

Victim received a text message claiming to be from their bank and had provided personal details including bank details. Action Fraud investigating.

06/08/22- Violence- Castleton

Traffic warden reports that after issuing a parking ticket, the car owner has been abusive and made direct threats towards them, then has driven the vehicle towards them, hitting their leg. Enquiries ongoing.

26/08/22- Suspicious Circumstances- Castleton

Victim reports someone repeatedly trying the door handle and then a car driving off – believed to be an attempted burglary. Safety advice given and patrols increased.

31/08/22- Theft- Ainthorpe

Theft of red diesel from a tractor tank, value of around £200. Victim just wanted incident logging.

04/08/2022- Drunk and Disorderly- Briggswath

One arrested for drunk and disorderly behaviour.

05/08/2022- Violence- Goathland

Victim reports being threatened by a large group of travellers due to her asking them to leave as they had parked in the school field. Officers attended, travellers were spoken to and were already moving on.

05/08/22- Public Order- Sleights

One male arrested for shouting and swearing in the street and trying to grab members of the public due to being intoxicated.

09/08/22- Road Related Offence- Aislaby

One vehicle seized for no insurance.

10/08/22- Road Related Offence -Sleights

One arrested after a motorbike failed to stop and the driver made off from the vehicle. The vehicle was seized and the driver later handed himself in to the police station. They admitted to failing to stop, no MOT and no insurance. They were also reported for careless driving.

12/08/22- Fraud- Ruswarp

Loss of £500 after the victim received a phone call stating they had won the lottery. Victim was asked to send £500 to a "solicitor" so the transfer could be made. Victim realised it was a scam after being asked to send more money. Action Fraud investigating.

22/08/22- Other Offence – Sleights

One illegal lock knife seized after being found in a holiday let. Owner had asked the home owner to send it to them through the post as they had forgotten it. Knife was collected and destroyed.
