Crime/Incident Breakdown

MULGRAVE GGN

02/09/22- Criminal Damage- Staithes

Reports of animal blood being smeared on a car, believed to be due to a neighbour dispute. No witnesses or CCTV – no further lines of enquiry. Safer Neighbourhood Team dealing with neighbour issues.

02/09/22- Road Related Offence- Newholm

One arrested for failing to stop, dangerous driving and driving whilst unfit through drink/drugs. Under investigation.

05/09/22- Burglary Residential Dwelling- Hinderwell

Reports that an elderly male has had around £1000 stolen from his home after a male pretending to be from Beyond Housing has entered his home. Under investigation.

05/09/22- Theft- Sandsend

Victim reports their wallet stolen from a public toilet. No lines of enquiry.

09/09/22- SMV- Staithes

Reports of a work van containing tools being stolen by an employee after a dispute over wages. The victim was later told where the van was and it was collected – did not want to pursue a complaint.

18/09/22- Police Generated- Sansend

One vehicle stopped and searched due to intel relating to drugs. Driver failed drug test and was arrested for drug driving.

24/09/22- Police Generated- Scaling Dam

One male arrested for breaching a court order.

29/09/22- Theft- Scaling Dam

Reports of a hydraulic trailer being stolen from a compound on the reservoir. Enquiries ongoing.

29/09/22- Theft- Hinderwell

Reports of fish being stolen from a garden, with garden furniture being moved to gain entry.

DANBY GGC

01/09/22 – Theft- Danby

Reports of a purse containing £500 cash being stolen from a home address, believed to have been done by a cleaner. No lines of enquiry.

17/09/22- Criminal Damage- Botton

Reports of a resident smashing plant pots and damaging plants. Officers attended but no complaints due to mental health issues, care managers are dealing with the situation.

A farmer reports that he believes his sheep are being purposefully run over as there had been 3 different incidents where his sheep had been hit resulting in either death or serious injury. Under investigation.
